The sustainable supply chain checklist.



Use this checklist to benchmark your operation across the six areas where supply chains cut waste, emissions, and cost – then talk to Taylor about closing the gaps.



Sourcing & Procurement

- ☐ Choose suppliers with public sustainability commitments
- ☐ Prioritize local & regional sourcing to cut transport miles
- ☐ Require environmental certifications (ISO 14001)
- ☐ Audit for ethical labor & responsible materials



Transportation & Freight

- ☐ Consolidate shipments to maximize trailer utilization
- ☐ Optimize routing to cut empty & deadhead miles
- ☐ Shorten shuttle distance with near-plant warehousing
- ☐ Track & report freight emissions per shipment



Warehousing & Facilities

- ☐ LED lighting with motion & daylight sensors
- ☐ Energy-efficient HVAC & cold storage
- ☐ Source renewable energy where available
- ☐ Repair & reuse pallets and racking



Packaging & Materials

- ☐ Use recyclable / recycled-content packaging
- ☐ Right-size cartons to reduce void & dunnage
- ☐ Eliminate single-use plastics where possible
- ☐ Adopt reusable totes for shuttle loops



Waste & Reverse Logistics

- ☐ Divert waste from landfill via recycling
- ☐ Run a returns program for reuse & restock
- ☐ Refurbish rather than dispose where viable
- ☐ Measure and publish your diversion rate



Measurement & Reporting

- ☐ Set an emissions baseline & reduction targets
- ☐ Track Scope 1, 2 & 3 emissions
- ☐ Share sustainability KPIs with customers
- ☐ Review progress against targets quarterly
